

The following web browsers have been tested and approved for use with CM/ECF:

FireFox 3.5 and 3.6

Internet Explorer versions 7 & 8

However, the latest versions of FireFox (ver 4.0 and 5.0) and Internet Explorer version 9.0 have not yet been certified to work with CM/ECF. Some users who have recently upgraded to these newer versions of these browsers have reported experiencing difficulties when interacting with CM/ECF. You may wish to consult with your technical support whether or not you should disable or forgo automatically upgrading your PCs to the newest version of these web browsers until the issues with CM/ECF can be resolved.

For information on how to edit your FireFox browser settings to prevent it from Automatically upgrading your FF browser please review the steps below:

To avoid automatic updates in FireFox, do the following:

1. On the menu bar (in FireFox browser), click Tools, and then click Options.  
The Options dialog box appears.
2. Click the Advanced icon, and then click the Update tab.
3. Under When updates to Firefox are found, select Ask me what I want to do.
4. Click OK.

Firefox will ask if you want to upgrade. If you select No Thanks, it will not install the update.
