ORDER CONVERTING CHAPTER 12 CASE TO A CHAPTER 11 CASE

[Movant's Name] has filed a motion, in accordance with 11 U.S.C. §1208 (e) seeking to convert this case to a case under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code (Title 11 of the United States Code). The court finds that the debtor is eligible to be a debtor under Chapter 11 and, after notice, that the motion should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. This Chapter 12 case is converted to a Chapter 11.
2. The Chapter 12 trustee shall:
 - a. forthwith turnover to the debtor or Chapter 11 trustee if one has been appointed, all records and property of the estate under his custody and control; and

- b. within 30 days, file a final report and account of all receipts and distributions made, together with a report on administration of the case, as required by 11 U.S.C. §704(a)(9).
3. The debtor, within 14 days of the date of this order, shall file;
 - a. a list of the debtor's equity security holders of each class, showing the number and kind of interests registered in the name of each holder and the last known name and address or place of business of each holder, as required by Bankruptcy Rule 1007(a)(3).
 - b. the statements and schedules required by Bankruptcy Rules 1007(b), if such documents have not already been filed.
 - c. a Statement of Current Monthly Income (Form B 22B).
4. The debtor, within 2 days of the date of this order, shall file a list of names, addresses and amount of claims of the creditors that hold the 20 largest unsecured claims, as required by Bankruptcy Rule 1007(d).
5. The Movant shall pay the \$800.00 filing fee within 2 (two) days of the entry of this Order pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §1930(a)(6). In order for the debtor's attorney to pay the fee online, the attorney shall file a text only entry in the case. Under the "Bankruptcy" heading in CM/ECF and under the "Other" category, the attorney will select the event "Filing Fee - Conversion to Chapter 11". After completing this entry, the attorney shall pay the fee electronically. Failure to do so shall result in dismissal of the case without further notice.

ORDER CONVERTING CHAPTER 12 CASE TO A CHAPTER 13 CASE

[Movant's Name] has filed a motion in accordance with 11 U.S.C. §1208(e) and Rules 9014 and 1017 (f)(1) Fed. R. Bankr. P., seeking to convert this case to a case under Chapter 13 of the Bankruptcy Code (Title 11 of the United States Code). The court finds that the debtor is eligible to be a debtor under Chapter 13 and, after notice, that the motion should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. This Chapter 12 case is converted to a Chapter 13.
2. The Chapter 12 trustee, within 30 days, shall file:
 - a. a final report and account of all receipts and disbursements made in the Chapter 12 case, and
 - b. a report on the administration of the case pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §704(a)(9).
3. The Chapter 12 trustee shall forthwith turnover to the Chapter 13 trustee a copy of

- the petition, schedules, all records and property of the estate remaining in the trustee's custody and control.
4. The trustee or any other party entitled to compensation may within 30 days of the date of this order file an application for compensation and reimbursement of expenses.
 5. The debtor, within 14 days of this order, shall file;
 - a. the statements and schedules required by Bankruptcy Rule 1007(b), if such documents have not already been filed.
 - b. a Statement of Current Monthly Income and Calculation of Commitment Period and Disposable Income (Form B22C) and,
 - c. a Chapter 13 Plan. If an extension is not granted by Court order, prior to the original due date, the Court will enter an ORDER DISMISSING your case without further notice or hearing.
 6. The Movant shall pay the \$35.00 filing fee within 2 (two) days of the entry of this Order pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §1930(a)(6). In order for the debtor's attorney to pay the fee online, the attorney shall file a text only entry in the case. Under the "Bankruptcy" heading in CM/ECF and under the "Other" category, the attorney will select the event "Filing Fee - Conversion Chapter 12 to Chapter 13". After completing this entry, the attorney shall pay the fee electronically. Failure to do so shall result in dismissal of the case without further notice.
