The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Oklahoma has undertaken a review of the local rules due to the implementation of the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act ("BAPCPA") in 2005, the adoption of the Interim Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the implementation of mandatory electronic filing using the CM/ECF electronic filing system, and the Statutory Time Period Technical Amendments Act of 2009.

Pursuant to Title 28, U.S.C. §2077(b), the court appointed a committee for the review of the rules of practice of the court. The committee consisted of the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court, bankruptcy practitioners, the Chapter 13 trustee, a panel trustee and the Assistant United States Trustee.

The revised local bankruptcy rules were renumbered to conform to the Uniform Number System approved by the Judicial Conference in May 2003.

The court has considered the committee's recommendations, given notice and the opportunity for public comment pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §2071(b), Bankruptcy Rule 9029 and Rule 83, Fed. R. Civ. P, considered the comments received and has adopted the attached revised Local Rules, Forms and CM/ECF Administrative Guide of Policy and Procedures to take effect December 1, 2009.

These rules shall apply to all pending, new and reopened cases and proceedings, except those local rules that result from a provision of the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 which shall not apply to those cases and proceedings where the act does not apply.

The revised local bankruptcy rules have been approved by the District Court of the Eastern District of Oklahoma.

In conjunction with the adoption of the revised local rules, all local forms, internal court forms, guidelines and instructions were reviewed and where necessary revised to conform to the revised local rules to reflect changes in the rules. All new local forms shall be identified with a date of 12/1/09. All other local forms with any other date should not be used.

On December 1, 2009 all previous versions of the local rules are abrogated and General Orders are rendered moot, through incorporation, in the revised local rules except as provided in these rules and General Orders numbered 09-01 and 09-02 adopting these rules and the following list of General Orders which shall be renumbered with the year they were entered and the corresponding number.
