**ORDER SETTING PRESUMPTIVE FEE FOR ATTORNEYS IN
CHAPTER 7 CONSUMER BANKRUPTCY CASES**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that effective December 1, 2014, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Oklahoma will allow \$1,750.00 as a reasonable, presumptive fee for attorneys in a basic consumer bankruptcy case filed under Chapter 7 of the United States Bankruptcy Code. Attorneys should charge less than this amount as circumstances warrant.
