- 4. The debtor, within 2 days of the date of this orders, shall file a list of names, addresses and amount of claims of the creditors that hold the 20 largest unsecured claims, as required by Bankruptcy Rule 1007(d).

- 3. The trustee or any other party entitled to compensation may within 30 days of the date of this order file an application for compensation and reimbursement of expenses.
- 4. The debtor, within 14 days of this order, shall file;
  - a. the statements and schedules required by Bankruptcy Rule 1007(b), if such documents have not already been filed.
  - b. a Statement of Your Current Monthly Income and Calculation of Commitment Period (Form 122C-1) and Calculation of Your Disposable Income (Form 122C-2)
  - c. a Chapter 13 Plan. If an extension is not granted by Court order, prior to the original due date, the Court will enter an ORDER DISMISSING your case without further notice or hearing.
- 6. The Movant shall pay the \$35.00 filing fee within 2 (two) days of the entry of this Order pursuant to 11 U.S.C. \$1930(a)(6). In order for the debtor's attorney to pay the fee online, the attorney shall file a text only entry in the case. Under the "Bankruptcy" heading in CM/ECF and under the "Other" category, the attorney will select the event "Filing Fee Conversion Chapter 12 to Chapter 13".
