## New Features of the U. S. Bankruptcy Unclaimed Funds Locator

The U.S. Bankruptcy <u>Unclaimed Funds Locator (UCFL)</u> consists of a public search web interface which allows public users to obtain information about unclaimed funds held by the bankruptcy courts. It is intended to facilitate drawing down the balance in U.S. Treasury Forfeiture Funds, which consists mostly of unclaimed bankruptcy funds. A nightly process updates the website with unclaimed funds data. <u>The UCFL has been updated to include the following new features:</u>

- Universal search functionality, which allows users to search for unclaimed funds owed to a specific individual, business, and/or governmental unit from one of the following:
  - A specific court district
  - Multiple court districts
  - o Across all bankruptcy courts within the entire judiciary
- Improved search functionality, which allows users to initiate a search based on the entry of a name into the Creditor Name and/or Debtor Name fields.

**NOTE:** The first and last name fields were combined into Full Text Indices to improve name searches. Creditor Name and Debtor Name only are available for search.

• Code modifications to only allow numeric values in the Amount field.
