ORDER CONVERTING CHAPTER 7 CASE TO A CHAPTER 11 CASE

A party in interest has filed a motion in accordance with 11 U.S.C. §706(b) and Rules 9014 and 1017 (f)(1), and (2), Fed. R. Bankr. P., seeking to convert this case to a case under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code (Title 11 of the United States Code). The court finds that the debtor is eligible to be a debtor under chapter 11 pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §706(d) and, after notice, that the motion should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. This chapter 7 case is converted to a chapter 11.
- 2. The debtor, within 14 days of the date of this order, shall file:

- a. a list of the debtor's equity security holders of each class, showing the number and kind of interests registered in the name of each holder and the last known name and address or place of business of each holder, as required by Bankruptcy Rule 1007(a)(3), and
- b. the statements and schedules required by Bankruptcy Rules 1007(b), if such documents have not already been filed.
- c. a Statement of Current Monthly Income (Form 122B).
- 3. The debtor, within 2 days of the date of this orders, shall file a list of names, addresses and amount of claims of the creditors that hold the 20 largest unsecured claims, as required by Bankruptcy Rule 1007(d).
- 4. The Chapter 7 trustee shall:
 - a. forthwith turnover to the debtor or chapter 11 trustee if one has been appointed, all records and property of the estate under his custody and control; and
 - b. in accordance with the U.S. Trustee's procedures, file a final report and account of all receipts and distributions made, together with a report on administration of the case, as required by 11 U.S.C. §704(a)(9).
- 5. The movant shall pay the \$755.00 filing fee within 2 (two) days of the entry of this Order pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §1930(a)(6). In order for the movant's attorney to pay the fee online, the attorney shall file a text only entry in the case. Under the "Bankruptcy" heading in CM/ECF and under the "Other" category, the attorney will select the event "Filing Fee Conversion to Chapter 11". After completing this entry, the attorney shall pay the fee electronically. Failure to do so shall result in vacating of the Order of Conversion without further notice.
